Virginia do hereby make and Ordain this my last
Will and Testament in manner and form as fol-
loweth that is to say - First I give all my
Land to my Eldest son J^r Black and his heirs
forever provided he shall maintain me (and my
wife Martha Black decently during our lives
and pay to the rest of my children the sums
hereafter named and all my lawfull debts (and
burying expences for both me and my wife)
that is to say - To my sons James Black and
William Black Ten pounds each
And To my son Joseph Black Thirty pounds
And To my son Benjamin Black five pounds
And To my daughter Elizabeth Black five pounds

And To my Two daughters Elizabeth Banning
and Jane Rusti each two pounds.

All the above named sums is to be paid by the
son John Black and out of the value of my
land and if he the said Black performs the
above mentioned conditions the said lands is to
be his his heirs and assigns forever and as to
what moveable Estate I shall have at my
decease it is to be sold and equally
divided among all my Children.

And I do hereby appoint my two sons John and
James executors of this my last Will and
Testament and I do hereby revoke all former
wills and Testaments by me made heretofore
in writing in whosoever I have heretofore set my
