property the lord has blessed me with in this life I will and bequeath in the follow-
ing manner that is to say I give the land I possess in Greenbrier County to my two
grand sons Henry Sher and James Crawford Sher sons of my son James Sher to be
equally divided between them to them and their heirs forever
I also give unto my three daughters Paddy Peggy & Hatty Sher the Plantations
I now live on with all stock implements of husbandry & furniture with all the move-
able and fixed I possess to them their heirs forever to be equally divided each to have
an equal share in all the above articles I constitute and appoint William Wilcox
my whole and sole executor of this my last Will and Testament & he is to pay all
my just debts and funeral expenses In witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal this 17th day of March in the year of our lord one thousand

The last Will and Testament of Henry Throld was produced
in Court & proved by the oath of the subscribing witnesses thereto & ordered to be

At Rockbridge Court April 30th 1810

On the motion of William Willson the only Son & Heir
Throld named who made oath according to Law & swore himself
granted him in due form and his goods, lands and security
and he together with John Willson his security entered
into and acknowledged Bond in the sum of \$3000
