In the name of God amen, this thirty first day of
May, in the year of our Lord, Eighteen hundred and
two, I Hugh Scott, of Rockbridge county, and state of
Virginia being weak of Body, but of sound mind and
Memory, and calling to mind the mortality of my body
knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die
do make this my last will and Testament in manner
and form following Viz it is my will and I order that
all my lawful debts & funeral charges be faithfully paid
by my Executors, and all Debts due to be collected by
and as touching what worldly Estate it hath pleased God
to bless me with in this life I will and bequeath in
the following Manner my land containing about one
hundred acres which I have

knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die
do make this my last will and Testament in witness
and foru telling Viz it is my will and I order that
all my lawful debts & funeral charges be faithfully paid
by my Executors, and all Debts due to be collected by
and as touching what worldly Estate it hath pleased God
to bless me with in this life I will and bequeath in
the following Manner my land containing about one
hundred acres which I purchased of Andrew Kennedy
and as he has not as yet made me a legal title for
it I hereby empower my Executors to take proper
measures for obtaining a Title for the same and
said land with the whole of my personal or

Movable Estate and what money may be on hand I
order and it is my will that it be equally divided among
my eight children (Viz) Hendry, Moses, Nancy, Sally, Eliza
Ann, Hannah, and Molly that is each of them an equal
share and I do hereby constitute and appoint my son
Moses Scott and my son in law Philip Reed sole execu-
tors of this my last will and Testaments and do hereby
disannul all other wills & Testaments by me heretofore
made In Witness where of I have herewith set my hand
and affixed my seal the day and year first above

At Rockbridge December court 1807

The last will & Testament of Hugh Scott deceased was produced in court proved by the oath of John Walker Peter Goummon two of the subscribing Witnesses thereto and Ordered to be recorded and Moses Scott one of the executors therein named having in open court relinquished his right of Executorship: On the motion of Philip Reed the other Executor who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form he having together with Emanuel Reed his security entered into Vachus whidgits bond in the penalty of Fifty pounds sterling conditioned according to law.
