form - first of all I give and Bequest To my
wife Annay Bailey all my household Furniture and
what shall be otherwise disposed of in in this my last
will and testament to be directed by her and the said

proper Bequest my two Daughters Namely Martha and Sally
at her Death — Secondly I Give and Bequeath to My
son William Bailey the tract of land I now live upon to
to him his heirs and assigns forever also all my farming
utensils also one Bed and furniture and all My stock
of all Descriptions out of which he is to give his mother
a decent and comfortable Maintenance in Diet and Clothing
During her natural life and to pay to each of his two Sis-
ters namely Martha and Sally each one hundred pounds
the Time of payment to Commence one year after my
decease in Yeas, at twenty five pounds yearly, ^{to each} until the whole
is paid up and to give each of them one cow when demanded
~~Thirdly I Give to my two Sons Namely Andrew and David~~
Bailey one tract of land lying and being in the county of

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Inhears in the state of Virginia and if either of them
should dye without heir the hole of s^d lands to go to the
surviving one or his heirs — fourthly I give and bequeath to
My Daughter Renah Hill five shillings To be paid by my son
William Bailey I do make order constitute and appoint my
Sons William Bailey and David Templeton My only and
sole Executors of this my Last will and testament and I do
hereby utterly disallow revoke and disannul all and every other
former wills and legacies and I do hereby confirm this and
no other to be my last will and testament In witness hereof I
have hereunto set my hand and seal this day and year above written
