 Elizabeth Beech Sarah Walker and Rachel Mitchell two Dollars
 each

Fourth I Bequeath to my two Daughters Margaret Harris and Mary
 McWalt Ten pounds each

Fifth I Bequeath to my son Michael all my farming utensils

Sixth I Bequeath to ~~the~~ my son Michael one half of the land

 likewise the part of the old survey that lies below a line mark-
 ed by him and his Brother Thomas

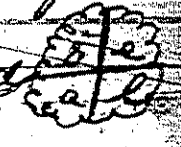
Seventh I Bequeath to my Son Thomas the upper half of the land

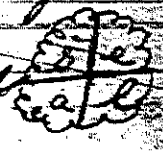
