straight line crossing a deep hollow to a black oak near a well
straight line to a washed fence in the meadow thence a short line to a well

by the corner of John Mc Nabbe's field and it strikes the old line remaining at

my time to three of all the product of my land for my daughter Sarah

James Mc Nabbe one black mare & two cows her share to be two hogs Pelion
during her single state of life I also bequeath to my daughter, her share of

the loom and lachings and spinning wheel and by wheel and all the deers

Yarnstead and one pot and oven and hatchet and I allow her to live with

mantle house I leave to my daughter Mary ten Shillings I leave to my

daughter Rebecca ten Shillings I leave to my daughter Lily a bed table

a cow or ten dollars I leave to my daughter Isabel a cow and bed

and three horse and a cart and harness in the mansion house I leave

and three hundred and a dole and her living in the maner of ~~her~~ her
to my son Alexander three thirds and all my farming utensils a
bunnet and a dole and you a large plot of my a large ~~plot of~~ ~~land~~
I have left my remaining debts to be equally divided between my ~~two~~ ~~sons~~
whom as there is a ballance of my property that is not mentioned after my
debts is paid I allow the ballance to my son Alexander
I do ~~with~~ ~~my~~ ~~son~~ ~~John~~ ~~Mc~~ ~~Call~~ ~~and~~ ~~my~~ ~~trusty~~ ~~friend~~
to execute the said last will and testament. Given under my hand
