der as near as I can my last will and Testament in manner
and form following; That is to say first and principally
I commend my Soul to Almighty God my Creator and
my ~~body~~ body to the Earth from whence it was taken to be
buried in such decent and Christian manner as my Ex-
ecutors hereafter named shall think meet and convenient
and as touching such worldly Estate as the Lord in mercy

and as tucking such worldly Estate as the Lord in mercy
hath lent me my will and meaning is the same that
it shal be employed and bestowed as hereafter men-
ed and by thus my will is Expressed first I allow my

body to be buried in a decent and Christian manner
out of my Estate — I by I give and bequeth to my
Son William Martin thirty three dollars and thirty three Cents
to be his share of my estate.
I by I give and bequith to my son James Martin thirty three Do-
llars and thirty three Cents to be his share of my Estate —

4 by I give and bequith to my son Jacob Martin son David
Martin thirty three Dollars and thirty three Cents and
to son Isaac Martin son John Martin seven Dollars
to buy her a Green time to be their share of my Estate.

5 by I give and bequith to my son Thomas Martin daughter

I can Maintain Seven Dollars to buy her a Gown that to be
her share of my Estate

6ly I give and bequeth to my Daughter Elisabeth Davis Seven
Dollars to buy her a Gown and a black Gown of mine to be
her share of my Estate

7ly I give and bequeth to my Daughter Margaret Perry the
ballene of my body Cloes my bed and bedding of Cloes
and a set of Wool Comes to be her share of my Estate

8ly I give and bequeth the ballene of my Estate to my Son
David Martin him his heirs Executors administrators
or assigns

9ly I adopt constitute and appoint my Sons William Martin
and David Martin my Executors
