unto my daughter Mary Goodbar after my Decease (or if she
should marry before my decease) one good horse, saddle
and bridle, two such cows as good as the best and best

cloaths, and all her clothing, the horse and harness to be taken
out of the horses, and cows which I have bequeathed unto my
said wife, and my son John, my said Daughter Mary is to
live on the plantation and is to be provided for in the same
manner as she was in mine and her mothers lifetime in
case she should survive us or marry, I give and bequeath
unto my Daughter Elizabeth Erwin one dollar and twenty
five cents to be paid by my executors six months after my
decease, I give and bequeath unto my son Joseph Goodbar
one Dollar and twenty five cents, six months after my

-tor of this my last Will and Testament, revoking and
