memory recalling to mind the mortality of my
body knowing that it is appointed for all men
once to dy do make and ordain constitute and
appoint this as my last Will and Testaments
First I reserve my soul into the hands of the
all mighty God who gave it and my body to
the dust from whence it came to be buried in a
Christian manner - Secondly I allow all my
just debts to be paid - Thirdly I allow my
son Henry Ginger to have the sole of the
plantation by him paying the balance of
the money that is coming to Wm Miller for
said land with the rest of the boys to assist
him in in paying said money for said place

the money that is coming to me I will give
sad land with the rest of the boys to assist
him in paying sad money for sad place
and my wife Anna Genger is to have her living
of sad land her lifetime and the sad Henry
Genger is to assist his mother to raise the
Family with the assistance of the rest of the
boys untill they arive to the age of eighteen
years then each and to be bound to some good
Trade and the said masters to give them and
years schooling and the Executors to see to it
Forthly I allow my son Henry Genger to pay
to each and of his brothers Twenty dollars in
cash when they arive to the age of Twenty
one years if they stay with him and work at
the Plantation til the age of Eighteen years

19 if they live him before that time then it is my
will that they should draw nothing of my
Estate and I allow my son Henry... Ginger
to pay to each one of his Sisters ten dollars
when they become of age - Fifthly I leave to
my beloved wife and to her yours all my per-
sonal Estate for her to manage the family
and to draw with it as she thinks best
And lastly I constitute and appoint my son Henry
Ginger & my father in law John Reed my
Executor in this as my last Will and Testament
witnessed with my seal and dated this 25th day of No-
vember in the year of our Lord 1811
