In the name of God amen I Martin Lee of Rockbridge

County and State of Virginia being weak and sick in
body but of sound mind and memory this twentieth day
May in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and
Six Do make publish and proclaim this my last will and
testament in form and manner following to wit:

1st Inprimis I will and desire that my body be decently buried
at the discretion of my Executors

2nd I desire that all my just debts be paid

3rd I give to my beloved wife Margaret see a part of the
land I now live on with the dwelling house barn
and orchard to be divided by a line to begin at a white
oak on my back line about two poles from the south west
corner of my field that line west of it

was my last will and
testament in form and manner following to wit
Imprimis I will and desire that my body be decently buried
at the discretion of my Executors

2nd I desire that all my just debts be paid


3rd I give to my beloved wife Margaret see a part of the
land I now live on with the dwelling house barn
and orchard to be divided by a line to begin at a white
oak on my back line about two poles from the south west
corner of my field that lay west of the great road thence
to run along side of a small meadow leaving the meadow
on the other part of my land but including the water on
my wife part of the land and also including the water

a small meadow that lay forming the creek on my wife
part of the land thence to run from a corner four poles above
a large sycamore a straight course across the hill to my east line -

I also give her an entry of ninety two Acres that lay be-
tween me and Andrew Graham also an entry of sixty acres
laying on the cone hill these I give to her and her heirs fore-
ever, I likewise give my wife the whole of my stock of Horses
Cattle sheep and Hogs and all my household furniture and all
my farming utensils I also give her all my slaves to be at her
disposal these I leave to her and her heirs forever.

The balance of my land not yet bequeathed I allow to
continue in the possession of my wife for and during the
term of four years after my decease and at the expiration
of four years if there is any crop on the ground she is to

have possession until the crop is reaped off, and then
I allow the said Land to be sold by my Executors and
money arising therefrom to be equally divided between
my five children - Dolly Knicker, John See, Cowrad See,
George See, Mary Leirous, but if any of these my
children should die before me then I allow their share to
fall to the heirs of their own body this I leave to them
and their heirs forever - all the grain that may be in
the ground the barn or crib at the time of my decease
I allow to my wife Margaret See - All the money,
rents and debts due to me at my decease I leave to my
wife Margaret See - I do hereby constitute and appoint
my true friends John Guy and John Brantley

whole and sole Executor of this my last will and testa-
mentary revoking and annulling all former wills or testa-
ments by me made in Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal this twentieth day of May
in the year one thousand eight hundred and six
