 things wherewith it hath pleased God to bless
 me with I dispose of it in the following manner
 First I give unto my daughter Eltham Eltham

422 my negro girl Ross to be hers & her heirs for
ever - Secondly I give unto my Daughters
Polly & Elleanor M^r Elhany all my other proper-
ty that I may be poss^{es}ed of at my death to be
equally divided between them by my Executors
Thirdly I give unto my daughter Jenny Harrison
Ten pounds to be paid by my daughter Elleanor
out of the legacy I left her - And I do hereby
constitute John Moor and John Willson to be
Executors of this my Will & Testament & I do
hereby utterly disanul all other wills legacies
or bequeathments by me heretofore made & I
do establish this my last Will & Testament
in witness whereof I have set my hand & seal
this Eighteenth day of Octo^r 1811

At Rockbridge County Court March 7th 1819

— The last Will and Testament of
Mary M. Eltham dec^d was presented in court

form and together with William Millson
their Security entered into and acknowl-
edged Bond in the penalty of \$1000 with legal
