that my Executors immediately after my death
shall cause to be made a just and true valua-
tion and appraisment of all my personal Estate
by honest & disinterested men whose certificate
of the sum of money it is worth shall be certified
by the valuers into Court and there recorded which
personal Estate shall remain on the plantation
except such parts of the same as said Executors
may think proper to dispose of ^{and} all the money
arising out of the sale of said personal Estate
said Executors shall think it in the benefit

of the Heirs to sell any part of it shall be paid
