Will & being in a sick and low condition but of a sound mind and memory

do and knowing that it is appointed for all men to die do make this

my last will & Testament (that is to say) I give my soul to god who gave

it my body I commit to the dust to be buried in a decent and Christian

manner at the discretion of my Executors - as to my estate which it has pleased

god to give me I bequeath and dispose of it in manner following from

after my just debts and burial charges is paid I give and bequeath

to my beloved wife one third of my land her life time also a horse

and saddle the horse to be such as she shall choose also two cows

& a bull and pasture I give to my Grandson Robert Hutchison three

hundred and fifty pounds & give and allow to my three

daughters Mary, Polly, Anna and Elizabeth each a sum of

Hundred dollars to each thirty three dollars and thirty four cents
I bequeath unto my daughter Martha Stuart one hundred and
sixty six dollars and sixty eight cents I bequeath Y to my three daughters
susanna Nancy and Mary one hundred acres of the land I
now possess to each of them thirty three acres and one third part if
my son Robert shall pay to each of my three daughters susanna
Nancy and Mary one hundred pounds on payment
after my death then my three daughters shall accept of it and the
one hundred acres shall be his but if he shall refuse to pay to them
or give them sufficient security for the payment of one hundred
pounds to each of them in the time above mentioned then the land
shall be theirs and then have the remainder of my land I also
and bequeath to my son Robert & to his heirs and assigns for ever
also give him my wagon two horses two vessels and all my pass-
ing Utensils I also give and allow to each of my three Daughters

I beleave Nancy & Mary a horse and saddle a bed & furniture I
also allow to my daughter Susana one hundred & thirty three dollars
and thirty four cents the remainder of my estate after the above de-
-queatments is paid I allow to be equally divided amongst my
three daughters Susana Nancy and Mary and lastly I appoint my
daughter Susana Executrix and my son Robt. Executor of this my last
will & testament and I do hereby revoke and disannul all former
wills and make this my last will and testament signed sealed pro-
-mised and declared to be my last will and testament this 31st day
of May 1806.

subscribing witnesses thereto with o'dorell to be recorded and
the said Susanna in open court refused to take upon herself
the Burthen of the execution of sd Will; On the motion of said
Robert Hutchinson Esq: for them named who made oath
according to law, certificate is granted him for obtaining pro-
bate thereof in due form he having together with Joseph West
& Samuel Campbell his securities entered into and acknowledged
bond in the sum of £3000 conditioned according to law
