body but of sound mind & memory do this eighteenth
day of August in the year one thousand eight hundred
and ten make and publish this my last will and
Testament in the manner & form following that is to say
I give and bequeath to my wife Margaret one house and
about two cows, a Bed and Clothing what of the
household furniture she may think proper for her own
use with the use of the house and a decent and plentiful
living of the plantation during her natural life
to my daughter Jane I bequeath the sum of ten Dollars
to my son William I give ten Dollars likewise over my
executors to make a right to him for nine acres and
one quarter of land joining himself and entry of

Alexander Trumbull and my land to my son
 Alexander the sum of two dollars to my son
 Patrick I give the sum of ten dollars to my da-
 ter Polly I give the sum of ten Dollars to my son
 John and James I give & bequeath the plantation
 I now live on likewise all the stock (except what is
 willed to my wife) likewise all the farming im-
 -pels with the balance of the household & Kitchen
 furniture when the land is divided I allow John
 his choice of the Division should either my son
 John or James die without marriage or heir their
 part of land shall be equally divided among the
 rest of my heirs to my daughter Elizabeth I give &
 bequeath one hundred and sixty six dollars Equally
 out of John & James share of my Estate with a-
 box & all to

out of John & James share of my Estate with a
bed & clothing as beacore & a boie and I make
and ordain my son Alexander & Alexander McBookie
(Black Smith) sole Executors of this my will in
virtue for the intent & purposes in this my will
contained. In Witness whereof I the said Samuel
McBookie have to this my last will & Testament
set my hand & seal the day and year afore written
signed sealed by the
said Samuel McBookie
as his last will and
Testament in presence of us
