of Virginia being in a sick and weake condition but ^{of} sound mind

and memory do make thus my last Will and Testament in manner
following (to wit) after my debts and burial charges is paid

I divide my estate in manner following I give to my son Wil-

liam the two Negroes Nat & Hanna which he has now in pos-

session I give the Land I now hold ^{in possession} to my son James and

his heirs for ever I also give to my S. son James my Negro

man Watt and my Negro boy Ben I also give to S. James all

my plantation implements also my large bible I give to my

son Samuel the two negroes he now has in possession to wit

Bill and Bob the Land I have in my son William I give

to

341.

To my son Samuel I allow my Executors to purchase too large be-
lie for my two sons William and Samuel I allow my Executors to have
the disposal of my Negro Woman Milley but they are not to sell her
nor let her suffer for want of a suitable support during her life time
the Bond I have on my son James I allow to his son Samuel to be paid
him with the Interest when he arrives to the age of twenty one the rest
of my Estate I allow to be equally divided amongst my three sons Wil-
liam James and Samuel the year old Colt now in possession of my
son William I give to his son Samuel I also appoint and constitute
my three sons William James and Samuel sole Executors of this my
last will and testament and do hereby disannul and Revoke all for-
mer Wills and make this my last will Witnefs my hand and Seal
this 12th day of May 1803

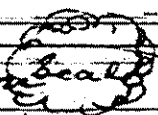
