I Samuel Wilson of Rockbridge County & State of Virginia do hereby make the following my last will & Testament (to wit)

First To my wife Mary Wilson I leave the house we now live in & kitchen together with my book case & clock & four of my slaves (to wit) Dick Joe Silla & Lewis to be at her disposal so long as she lives & at her death to be disposed of as hereafter directed & the balance of my household & kitchen furniture together with one hundred pounds in cash, the choice of my hand creature, three cows & as many sheep as will be sufficient to furnish

clothing for herself & negroes to be entirely at her disposal & to be left to whomsoever she pleases & that she is to be furnished by my son Robert with sufficient provisions for herself negroes & block so long as she shall live & that Joe is to work on the farm with Robert as he has done heretofore

second To my son Robert Willson I leave all my lands to him this heirs together with all my farming utensils & my negro man Joe after the death of my wife also my book case & block

Third To my Daughter Betsey Lindsey I leave my negro boy Daniel to be delivered to her at any time she shall demand him

Fourth To my Daughter Sally Whinston I give my negro girl Silla after the death of my wife

fifth To my son Hugh Willson My Daughter Betsey Lintz

I give my negro woman Suck My negro boy Lewis at
the death of my wife & if they do not choose to take

5 negroes they are to be sold & the price to be equally
divided between them

Sixth That all my live stock except what is before men-
tioned shall be sold & the money arising therefrom

together with all my outstanding debts & cash
which I shall die possessed of, after paying all my


just debts & funeral charges to be equally divided
between my fair children Hugh, Betsey, Sally & Silla

Seventh I do hereby constitute & appoint my son Robert
& my friend William Willson whole & sole executor
of this my last will & testament

together with Hugh Willson John Ruff their securities
entered into & acknowledged bond in the penalty of
fifteen thousand dollars conditioned according to
law.
