tion I shall receive the same again by the Mighty Power of God
and as concerning such Wordly Goods wherewith it hath pleased
God to Bless me in this life I give Devise and Dispose of the
same in the manner and form following (Wt)

First I order and it is my Will that my Just debts and

funeral charges be paid by my Executors

Imprimis I give and bequeath unto ^{my} Beloved wife Sarah
one half of my land and the one half of my movable Estate to
be for her use and at her disposal for ever

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Joseph fifteen pound
in three different payments of five pound a year
the first to be payd two years after my decease and five pound
every year untill the above fifteen pound is paid

Item I give and bequeath unto ^{my} son David the one half of
my land and the one half of my Movable Estate to be at his
use and disposal for ever

Item I give and bequeath unto my son John Eighteen
pound

Item I give unto my Daughter Rebecca the full
further order and it is my Will that if any one or both
my sons Joseph and John die before the above Cash is paid
them their share shall be Equally divided amongst their sur-
vivors.

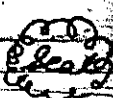
Lastly I do make ordain constitute and appoint my Wife
