Testament in manner following (to wit)

First I give to my wife Dolly Thompson her heirs
Executors ^{or} administrators all my lands left me by
the last Will and Testament of my father John
Thompson dec^d part of which land he gave me
an obligation for bearing date the twentieth day
of February one thousand seven hundred and
ninety seven & recorded in the Clerks office of
this County and the other part being the one
half of an Entry made by & my father and
patented in his name, adjoining the lands of
Patrick Neil dec^d & Daniel Cyrus & all my horses
cows & live stock of every kind farming utensils

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household furniture & every other species of property
including cash bonds and accounts which I
shall direct to be paid for the paying all my just
debts & funeral expences -

Second - I give to William Willson Fifty dollars
to be paid him for acting as executor of this
my last Will and Testament -

Lastly - I hereby appoint my wife Dolly Thompson
son my ^{Executor} and my friend William Willson

to Execute this my last Will and Testament
