This Deed of Emancipation from Thomas Cunningham to his Slave Judy was produced in court, proved by the oath of John Irvine & John Williford two of the subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded

I Valentine Coffell of Rockbridge County and State of Virginia do hereby make my last will and testament in form and manner following 1st I desire that my body may be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors, and all my just debts paid—
2nd I give my wife Catharine Coffell all my movable estate to be at her disposal this I give to her and her heirs forever
3rd I give my daughter Elizabeth Paul five pounds this I give to her and her heirs forever

4th I give my son Jacob Cofwell one hundred pounds
of the price of my Land this I give to him and his heirs forever

5th I give my daughter Magdalene Nicholas one hundred pounds to be paid
out of the price of my Land this I give to her and her heirs forever

6th I give my son Henry Cofwell one hundred pounds to be paid out
of the price of my Land this I give to him and his heirs forever

7th I give my son Augustine Cofwell one hundred pounds to be paid
out of the price of my Land this I give to him and his heirs forever

8th I give my daughter Catherine Bright one hundred pounds to be
paid out of the price of my Land this I give to her and her heirs forever

9th I give my daughter Mary Rust one hundred pounds to be paid
out of the price of my Land this I give to her and her heirs forever

10th I give my son Henry Cofwell one tract of Land laying on west
side of the Big Calpasture River on which he now lives known by the

name of the entry also all the new entries adjoining provided he pay
my son Augustine Cofwell thirty five pounds in one year after my

death and twenty five pounds in one year after my son Nicholas and son

~~to be paid by my son Augustus to Magdalene Nicholas within~~
ty five pounds to Catharine Bright in three years twenty five pounds
to Magdalene Nicholas in four years after my decease this I leave to him
and his heirs forever

1st I give my daughter Mary Rust one tract of land on which I now
live laying on both sides of the Big Catpastone River joining John
Magor's land also one entry of fifty Acres joining Lees land provided
she pay my son Augustine Cofwell sixty five pounds in one year
after my decease fifteen pounds to Magdalene Nicholas and fifteen
pounds to Catharine Bright in two years after my decease thirty pounds
to be equally divided between Magdalene Nicholas and Catharine Bright
in three years and twenty five pounds to Magdalene Nicholas in
four years and forty five pounds to Catharine Bright in five years after
my decease and one hundred pounds to my ^{son} Jacob Cofwell to be paid
in two payments fifty pounds in six years and fifty pounds in seven
years after my decease

12th I give my wife Catharine Cofwell the half of the third of all
the grain that will be raised on the two places above named

11th I give my daughter Mary Rust one tract of land on which I now live laying on both sides of the Big Catpasture River joining John Magals land also one entry of fifty Acres joining Leas land provided she pay my son Augustine Cofwell sixty five pounds in one year after my decease fifteen pounds to Magdalene Nicholas and fifteen pounds to Catharine Bright in two years after my decease thirty pounds to be equally divided between Magdalene Nicholas and Catharine Bright in three years and twenty five pounds to Magdalene Nicholas in four years and forty five pounds to Catharine Bright in five years after my decease and one hundred pounds to my son Jacob Cofwell to be paid in two payments fifty pounds in six years and fifty pounds in seven years after my decease.

12th I give my wife Catharine Cofwell the half of the third of all the grain that will be raised on the two places above named and for and during her natural life I do hereby nominate and appoint my son Thomas Cofwell and Jonathan Rust as executors of this my last will and testament in writing before

I have set my hand and seal this fifth day of February, 1806

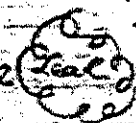
