of November one thousand eight hundred I William
Thompson of Rockbridge County and State of Virginia
calling to mind the mortality of my body and

knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do
make and ordain this to be my last will and testament
that is to say principally and first of all I give and recom-
mend my soul into the hand of Almighty God that give
it and for my body I recommend it to the earth to be
buried in christian like and decent manner at the dis-
cretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the
great and general resurrection I shall receive the same
again by the mighty power of God and as touching such
worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased god to bless me with
in this life I give bequeath and dispose of in the follow-
ing manner and form here I give to my beloved

the wife of my household furniture

wife Margret Thompson the hole of my household
to be divided as she may think proper amongst my chil-
dren

Secondly I give and bequeath to my three sons

Viz John William and James my hole lands and

tenements to them their heirs or assigns forever also my

hole stock of all descriptions only what shall hereafter

be disposed of in this my last will and testament and

of which they are to pay all my just debts and to give

their mother a decent and comfortable support in

duet and Cloathing and to keep her in a good house and

estate during her natural life also to give their two

daughters Mary and Anne the like comfortable support

of duet and decent Cloathing together with their own

Secondly I give and bequeath to my three sons
Viz John William, and James my whole lands and
tenements to them their heirs or assigns forever also my
whole stock of all descriptions only what shall hereafter
be disposed of in this my last will and testament out
of which they are to pay all my just debts and to give
their mother a decent and comfortable support in
diet and clothing and to keep her in a good house and
saddle during her natural life also to give their two
daughters Mary and Agnes the like comfortable support
of diet and decent clothing together with their own
modest whole they continue unmarried and to furnish

Agnes in a horse and saddle equal to ones that I hereafter
 shall leave to my daughter Mary in this my last will
 and Testament and also to pay to their two sisters namely
 Mary and Agnes each one hundred pounds to be paid
 in twenty five pound quarts to each of them yearly
 after they arrive to the years of twenty one thirdly I give
 and bequeath to my daughter Mary one sorrel Stear
 now betwixt two and three years old also the
 saddle they now claim. I do make ordain
 constitute and appoint my son John Thompson and
 James Patton Senior my only and sole Executors of
 this my last will and Testament and I do hereby utterly

disallow revoke and disallow all and every other former
wills and legacies and I do hereby confirm this and
no other to be my last will and testament. In Witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
twenty first Day of November one thousand eight
hundred. Signed sealed published and declared
