to be divided in three equal Annual sales -
the purchaser or purchasers to give their bonds
to them therefor with approved security -
Further I direct my executors to sell my
mess and saw mill with the lot of land
they stand on with the other improvements
(situated in Accutaw County) for the best price

my death as they see proper to sell my lands
in Rockingham at publick or private sale
for the best price that they can get in twelve
Months after my decease, One thousand
dollars to be paid in hand and the balance
to be divided in three equal Annual sales -
the purchaser or purchasers to give their bonds
to them therefor with approved security -
Further I direct my executors to sell my
Mills and saw mill with the lots of land
they stand on with the other improvements
(even in Augusta County) for the best price
that they can get either by publick or
private sale within the time of two years
after my death, the sale of this property they
are to have advertised in one of the Gazettes
in the city of Richmond and in one in
Staunton at least three Months and
expressly before the sale, one half of the price
of said Property to be paid down by the purchaser

And the balance to be paid in four equal
payments from that time, the purchaser or purchasers
giving their bonds to him therefor, with approved security
the two lots that I own in Weymouth I direct
my executors to make sale thereof either public
or private, as they may think proper for the best
price that they can get as soon after my death as
will be in their power and secure the payment
by taking good security for such part of the purchase
money as may not be paid down at the time of
the Purchase, I direct my executors to make title
to all the lands that I have hereby directed them
to sell at the time of the first payments of such land
if either of my executors or both of them should happen
to be purchasers of any of all my real estate then
in that case, I direct that the other make the
title to the one that is the buyer - Fifthly I direct
my executors to pay of all my last debts, funeral
expenses costs of administration and legacies the
balance of my estate I direct to be equally
divided among my brothers and sisters in case
of either of them before they are married, their heirs

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to all the lands that I have hereby directed them
to sell at the time of the first payments of such land
if either of my executors or both of them should happen
to be purchasers of any of all my real estate then
in that case, I direct that the other make the
title to the one that is the buyer. — Fifthly I direct
my Executors to pay of all my last debts, funeral
expences costs of Administration and Legacies the
balance of my estate I direct to be equally
divided among my brothers and sisters in case
of either of them before they receive their part,
then I direct that I go to their price, and divide
among them equally, Sixthly I have hereby nominated
and appointed my loving Brothers, Henry Rode and
Frederick Rode to be my executors to this my last
will and testament. Nothing doubting but all that
I have directed them to do will be carefully and
and faithfully performed. In witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand and seal the 27th
of January 1786 and I direct that the same
