In the name of God Amen I Peter Bright
of the County of Shamandoah and state of Virginia
sick and weak of body but of sound and perfect
mind and memory thanks be to god for the same
Therefore calling to mind the mortality of my
body and knowing that it is appointed for all
men Once to die do make and Ordain this
my last will and testament in the presence of
and form following; First I give and bequeath

the paper for her use as long as she lives except
my tract of land lying in Rockingham County
thirteen Acres and a half for which I have a
Deed in the Office, it Joining sheets and all the land
the aforesaid land is to be sold as soon as
possible after my Decease and my beloved wife
is to receive the one third part of the money
that is arising of the land for her use as long
as she lives and the remainder part of the money
Arising of the land is to be put on interest
for my three Children untill they arrive to their
Lawful ages then Equally to be divided between
my three Children that is to say George Bright
Peter Bright and John Bright, Item my will
and desire is that after my said wifes decease
all the movable property and the third part
of the money of the aforesaid land sold for her

that is arising of the land for her use as long
as she lives and the remainder part of the money
arising of the land is to be put on interest
for my three children until they arrive to their
lawful ages then Equally to be divided between
my three children that is to say George Bright,
Peter Bright and John Bright, Item my will
and desire is that after my said wifes decease
all the movable property and the third part
of the money of the aforesaid land sold for her
use as long as she lives for her necessary use
then if any remaining to be equally divided
amongst my above named children and her two
youngest John Belkumer and Mary Belkumer when
they arrive to their lawful ages in Equal shares
them or their heirs forever, it is my will &
desires that my Executors is to make a lawful

Frederick Kline Executors of this my La
st Will & testament, I do hereby Disallow re
and utterly Disallow and Every other
testament will legacies bequeaths and Exe
by me in any way before named wills or be
This ratifying confirming this and no other
be my last will and testament
signed sealed published Declared & pronounced
by the said Peter Bright as his last
Will and testament who in these Peter Bright
presents and in the presents of each
Other have hereunto subscribed Our
names this Thirteenth day of January
one Thousand Eight hundred and three. 1863
