same in the following manner that is to
say I Give and bequeath to my wife
Margaret the whole of my movable ~~estate~~
property, Nevertheless subject to the payment of
all my last Debts which I have legally

such worldly goods as hath pleased god to
bless me with in this life I dispose of the
same in the following manner that is to
say I Give and bequeath to my wife

property, Nevertheless subject to the payment of
all my Just Debts which I have legally
contracted and the balance for her to receive
and keep in her hands for her own use until
her death or marriage which ever happens first
then I direct whatever of my estate of my
estate, will be in her hands to be equally divided
among my children by name, Jacob, Michael
Henry & Isabella or Ann and as for my land
I likewise leave it to my said wife during

Jacob to him his heirs and assigns
be paying the sum of One hundred sixty six doll
Sixty seven cents in twelve monthly times after he
receives the full possession of this my place to
my daughter Elizabeth Gritz, and in twelve
months from that time the sum of One hundred &
Sixty six dollars and sixty seven cents to Rosena
Shaver my second daughter, And in twelve
months from that time to my daughter Catharine
Christ the sum of One hundred and sixty six doll
and 67 cents & in twelve months from that
to my son George Sipe the sum of One hundred
and sixty six dollars and 67 Cents, in twelve
months from that time to my daughter Mary
Hartney the sum of One hundred sixty six dollars
and 67 cents, and in twelve months from that
time the sum of One hundred sixty six dollars
Sixty seven cents, to my son John Sipe, in twelve
months from that time to my daughter Marg
Blauzer the sum of One hundred & sixty six dollar

months from that time to my daughter Catharine
Christ the sum of One hundred and sixty six dollars
and 67 cents & in twelve months from that time
to my son George Sipe the sum of One hundred
and sixty six dollars and 67 cents, in twelve
months from that time to my daughter Mary
Hartney the sum of One hundred sixty six dollars
and 67 cents, and in twelve months from that
time the sum of One hundred sixty six dollars
thirty seven cents, to my son John Sipe, in twelve
months from that time to my daughter Marge
Blanger the sum of One hundred & sixty six dollars
and sixty seven cents, in twelve months from that
time the sum of One hundred and sixty six dollars
sixty seven cents to my daughter Mary Magdalene
and then to pay to my son Michael Sipe in two
years from that time in two equal gales the sum
of Three hundred and thirty three and thirty four
cents & in two years from that time in two equal
annual payments the sum of three hundred

and I give to them and each of them
their heirs and assigns forever, in Case of the
death of either of them before they receive their
hereditary share, then in that Case I direct
that their part go to their lawful issue if they
have any if they not to be equally divided among
all my Children. All this I expect will be
carefully done and performed by my ~~loving~~
Margaret & my nephew Henry Sipe, who
I do hereby appoint my whole and sole
Executrix and Executor to this my last
will and testament. In Testimony
whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal this 24th day of March 1800

Rockingham June Court 1800
The last will And testament of Peter Sipe dec. was
presented in Court and proven by the oaths of Robert Gratton
and George Hurton two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be
recorded, and on the motion of the executor therein named
who made oath thereto and with security entered into
