Memory thanks be to God for the same, and calling
to mind the mortality of man, I do therefore
make this my last will and Testament in the
following manner and form, First it is my will
that after all my funeral charges are paid, then
shall all my movables be appraised and sold and
Also my plantation in said county containing one
hundred & five acres of land where the widow Bright
now lives on shall also be sold and after all
my Just Debts are paid then shall the remainder
of my money be divided among two of of my brothers
and One of my sisters it is my will that my
sister Catharine shall have the one half of said
money for herself and her heirs forever, Item it
is my will that my Brother John Kool

two shares for him and his heirs forever. And my Brother Ernst Kool shall have the remaining
for himself and his heirs forever. And I do also choose
Appoint my two friends Viz John Kool and Jacob Garber Executors
of this my last will and testament in trust that
will take care & perform the same according to my
intent and meaning. Item it is my will that my Executors
shall make a good & lawful Deed to the purchaser
shall buy my said Land and to his heirs or assigns
Item it is my will that this my last will and
testaments shall soon after my death be truly copied
into English under the care of my executors and the
english copy with the original shall be truly delivered
in court & put in records. In Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and seal as & for my last will
Testament this eleventh day of March in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred & five 1805.

This last will and testament of Philip Kool esq^r was
in court and proved by the Oaths of John Roles and
Garber two witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And
the motions of John Kool and Jacob Garber the executors
named who made Oath thereto and with security entered
into and acknowledged bond in the sum of two thousand
conditioned as the law directs a certificate as
