have in payment what I owe for her Childrens board & you also

sons & Daughters the sum of Twenty five Pounds to be paid in the
old way and be equally divided amongst them my said son
Jacob shall pay when he comes to the age of one & twenty

pounds is paid (viz) my son Jacob is to pay to my sons Peter
John, Philip, & my wife and my son Ab^m shall pay to my
sons & Daughters (viz) to Peter, John, Philip & Daughters
among the sum of Twenty five pounds to be paid the old
