in this life: I Do leave & bequeath in the manner
as followeth. first of all I leave and bequeath on
to my Dear and loving Wife the full power of
my plantation where I now live to her
disposal to her death also I leave her the best
house & add to on the plantation bet & between

Two bones at ^{her} own disposal and as for the rest
of my movable estate I leave it to be sold at
publick Vendue and after all Just Debts and
funeral Charges is paid, It is to be disposed of
in manner following in the next place I leave
and bequeath on to my son Alexander Campbell
the plantation where I now live after he comes
at the age of Twenty one to him and the lawful
heirs of his body for ever but if his mother
should survive till he of age she is to have
full power as usual on the plantation also
I leave to my son Black one bay horse and
buck and saddle and for what money I have
I leave to ^{my} beloved wife and Daughter Letty
I also leave and bequeath on to my Daughter
Letty all my silver and furniture and

bequeath to my Daughter Catherine Campbell
one growing young black mare on broke and
saddle and bridle and one cow I also leave
and bequeath unto my Grand Child Samuel
one heath and saddle when he comes to the age
of discretion and as for the rest of my move-
able Estate I leave it to be sold and divided
equally among my Children to each an equal
part and it is also my Will and desire that
my Dear and Loving Wife John Wilson
should be my sole and sole Ex^{or} of this
my last Will and Testament and I do here-
by Revoke and disannul all other will and
Testaments or legacies ever made or made by me
ratifying and confirming this and no other

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last Will and Testament to which
Witness hereof I set my hand and seal this
Twenty seven Day of December In the year of
our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ one
Thousand Seven hundred and Eighty three
