for it. I do think proper to make this my Last Will and Testament
which I do in the following Manner and in the first place I order
& direct that all my Just Debts together with the funeral Expenses
be paid & Discharged after my Death as soon as convenient
by my Executors hereinafter named & Appointed. And I do just
give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife Anne Voelchner who shall
have full sole Possession and house room on the Plantation whereon
I now live during the time she the said Anne Voelchner my said wife
Remains my Widow During her Natural Life and if my said wife
do marry again with another husband than I order and
direct that she with her husband or such husband shall Depart from
my said Plantation aforesaid and have her Dower only and I
order & direct that my Executors shall have Power and full Authority
hereunto & observe that no waste of Timber Nor shall any be sold from
my said Plantation without their leave and I further allow unto
my Wife Anne Voelchner the sum of \$1000 Dollars to be paid to her

hereto & observe that no waste of Timber nor shall any be sold from
my said Plantation without their leave and I further allow unto
my Wife Anne During her Widowhood the use of my said Plan-
tation as aforesaid In Case she will agree with my Executors
if they or there assignees shall think yet to bring up my before-
mentioned now if they remain with the said after her decease my
said Plantation I give and bequeath unto my said Wife Anne
is to say to my Son John, Harvey, and Sam Vochner and Ca-
tharine Richards the wife of George Richards & Magdalene Vochner
to them and to their heirs or assigns for ever Jointly, Share & Share-
alike. And I also give and bequeath unto my before said Wife Anne
In Case my Personal Estate shall be more then sufficient to pay
my Debts & Expenses of Estate all the Remainder of my Estate last
mentioned and I do order & Direct and my Will is if my said
Wife Anne and my said Executors cannot agree upon and a-
greeable to this Will Contract for and in Compensation with her
Selle or reasonable Sum for the benefit of my said

Children herein after named shall have full power and Authority in their
Execution to do and provide in so far forth manner as they shall think fit
or Estates as my said Children may be entitled to and pay them any
part or all at any time convenient and lawful Part or Proportion
of my Plantation growing due & payable after my Decease to be paid
by and unto it in Discretion. And I do hereby nominate and
Appoint my Brother Henry Wetchnor, Alexander and Jacob Hickley
to be the Executors to this my Last Will & Testament hereby allowing
this and no other to be my last Will & Testament. In Witnes whereof

and in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & Eighty
Seven
