I Give & bequeath unto my dear and loving Son James Bradwell & Isaac
Bradwell all my Land as Kentuckys to be Divided between them Next
I Give and bequeath to my son George all the lower part of my plantation
and last of Land from the mouth of the Run that flows through the
meadow by a line 10 Yards from the mouth of the said run south
West to the outside line, and that the Division
shall be made and equal to my son George
