At the time of my death I would wish my body
to be buried in a body but of perfect mind and memory. Thanks be to God for his goodness of
allowing me to have the modicuity of my body and knowing that it is appointed
for all men and to him do I make this my last will and testament that it may
be understood first of all my will is that all my just debts and funeral charges
be paid and satisfied. Then I give and bequeath unto my will beloved friend
John Balon all my plantation where I now live or hereafter may be.
to share and divide the said plantation six years and until then there
is to be no division of the same. But if any man or woman shall die

I should chuse to die before he came to the age of twenty and to have all
my substance or either of them their houses and all effects for ever. I do give and
bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Rebekah Niles my riding mare and all the
rest of my moveable estate & I do also bequeath unto my beloved son Daniel and

Daughter Elizabeth the same horse and all her effects for ever. And I do give and
bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Elizabeth my riding mare and all her
other horses and effects for ever, and I do appoint my son Daniel Niles to be execu-
tor of this my last will and testament statifying and conforming this and no other
to be my last will and testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal this nineteenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven
