bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Rebekah Nolen my riding mare and all the
rest of my moveable estate I give and bequeath unto my beloved son Daniel and
my Daughter Elizabeth Nolen to be equally divided between them to have
their heirs and assigns forever, and I do appoint my son Daniel Nolen to be ex-
ecutor of this my last will and testament Ratifying and confirming this and no other
