I give to my beloved daughter, Ann, my personal estate of what kind soever during her natural life, it is my Will & Desire that my lands shall be sold and the sale thereof to be paid and applied to my beloved daughter, Ann, my daughter and Hawthorn Road, Executors and Administrators of this my last Will and Testament, making void all other Will or Wills by me made and ratifying and confirming this my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and the seal of my said daughter, Ann, this 17th day of January 1776.
