

In the Name of God Amen I Frederick Andrick of Dunmore County in the Colony of
Virginia, being weak in body but of sound and disposing mind and Memory, do make and
publish this my last will and Testament in manner and form following, First my beloved
wife Anna Andrick shall have full possession of all my estate in what she is entitled to
I Frederick Andrick come to age of one and twenty years if in last my personal Estate shall
be sufficient to pay all my debts; but if my personal Estate shall not be sufficient to discharge
my Debts then my Executors hereafter mentioned shall have full power and lawful authority
to sell any part or parcel of my Land I now hold in Dunmore County in the Colony of Virginia and
make payment to my Creditors, but if in leasing my debts can be paid without selling
any of my Land, then my wife Anna Andrick shall still have the third part of my s^d Land
till my son Frederick Andrick comes to age during her natural life, and after her decease I
give and bequeath all my Land above mentioned to my three sons viz to Frederick Andrick
to George Andrick and to Jacob Andrick, each one to have an equal share with the other, to them
and their Heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns forever
Also I give to my said wife Anna one feather bed, one chest, one spinning wheel, one trying pan, and
one small iron pot & two pewter basins and one hoop
Also I do make and Ordain my beloved friends John Keller and Jacob Rinker Junr. sole Executors of
this my last Will and Testament to take care and see the same performed, according to my true in-
tent and meaning

hand & seal this eighth day of September In the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & seventy
four 1774
