ing to mind the mortality of my Body and knowing that
it is appointed for all men once to die do make and Ordain
this my last will and Testament that is to Say Princi-
pally and first of all I give and Recommend my soul
into God that gave it and for my Body I Recommend it
to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like manner at the
Discretion of my Executors Nothing Doubting But at the
General Resurrection I shall Revive the again by the mighty
Power of God and as touching such worldly Estates as it
has Pleased god to Bless me with in this life I Give
and Dispose of the same in the following manner: I form

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~~Supermines it is my will & Do order that in the first~~
Place all my Just debts and funerals charges be Paid
and satisfied then I Give and bequeath unto my
three sons Mordecai the lower end of my Land
where he now lives on and I Give unto my son Daniel
the Place which he now lives on and to my son
William the upper end of Land the Place which
he now occupies the three Pieces is to stand as they

marked out from the River to the Bank line on hapshill Creek
the three Places which I have forementioned I Give to them and
their heirs forever that is 400 Acres Land I Give unto my Daugh-
~~ter Mary~~ ~~one Shilling~~ ~~unto my Daughter Elizabeth one~~
Shilling and my Daughter Hannah one Shilling and my
Daughter Nancy one Shilling and I Give to my Daughter Mary
one Cow or the price of a Cow and all moveable Estate is to be sold
and to be Equally to be Divided Between my two youngest Daugh-
ters Margaret and Winifred to be Paid to them as they come of age
at the years of Eighteen and I hereby do appoint & ordain my son
William Cloud and my son Daniel Cloud to be my only and
Sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament and I do hereby
utterly Disallow Revoke and Disannull all and every other former
Testaments Wills and Executors by me Before This Time Made
being and confirming this to be my last Will and Testament
unless Revoked by me hereafter In Witness Whereof I have here

unless Proved by me hereafter I do Witness Wherof I have now
unto set my hand Seal the Day & Year above written &
Signed Sealed and Acknowledged.

the 9th day of September 1786

Executors therein named came into Court and Refused to take
the Burthen of the Execution thereof upon themselves
