I Ordain this my last will & testament in manner
following I Recommend my soul into the hands of
Almighty God that gave it & my body I Recommend to
the Earth to be buried in a Decent Christian Burial at
the Discretion of my Executors & as touching such
worldly Estate which with it hath Pleas'd God to bless
me with in this life I give Devise & Dispose of the
same in the following manner & form

First it is my will that my Dear Beloved wife Bar-
bara shall live on my place or plantation as I now
live on during her natural life & to have Liberty and

God calling unto Me and the Mortality of my body as He
hath Ordain'd this my last will & Testament in manner
following I Recommend my Soul into the hands of
Almighty God that gave it & my body I Recommend to
the Earth to be buried in a Decent Christian Buriall at
the Discretion of my Executors & as touching such
worldly Estate wherewith it hath Pleas'd God to bless
me with in this life I give Devise & Dispose of the
same in the following manner & form

First it is my will that my Dear Beloved wife Bor-
lana shall live on my place or plantation as she
live on during her natural life & to have Liberty and
privilege in full as aforesaid & that the Children
shall stay with her each untill it comes to its lawfull
age & Obey her in all things as becometh Obedient.

Whichever of them shall be the more reasonable & take satisfaction
in my being as the law of the man allowy I will do it
if there should appear any effects as could be spared it
it may well such may be done if that the money to be
made in husbandry to be applied to the use of her & the
Children but if she should die before all the Children come
of Age then it should be made as the very thing may be equal
by divided among all my Children whatsoever Remains
yet left of the Estate of a best Care to be taken of Security
of the Children yet under age of being eldest son John
I gave & bequeath one hundred acres of land in that part
where the big field is where he is now building his house
but if so that one hundred acres be off both not come
Down far enough to take in the P house then shall
add somewhat to it as will take it in so as not to hurt
the house place which I land & tenement gave and

the house place which I had by bequest given and
bequeath to him for him & his heirs & assigns for ever
whom he likewise Constituted make Governor the sole
Executor of this my last will & Testament & that he should
Intestate with his Mother & advise her in all need full
cases of a strict Disease if it should appear & be thought
Convenient that these might be two great reasons of the
Annulment of my said Land with the new Survey adjoining
them it shall be left to the choice of the other of my Sons
to have them for them & their heirs & assigns for ever and
shall be divided and done with equally & that each said
Child of my one herein mentioned it shall be left to the
Judgment of Reasonable men the Valuation of each place
& that after receiving their own equal share out of my
Valuations shall give of each of my Children an equal
share out of the same (Viz) all my Children to have

Execution of my will

I being with his Mother Godwise herein a needfull
 case of a steppes Disease if it should appear to be thought
 convenient that these might be two great talents of the
 same name of my P. Land with the new survey adjoining
 them it shall be left to the choice of the other of my Sons
 to have them for more of them here of a purpose for some use
 shall be divided and some with equality of that each said
 Place of anyone herein mentioned it shall be left to the
 Judgment of Reasonable men the Valuation of each place
 of that after receiving their own equal share out of P.
 Valuation shall give of each of my Children an equal
 share out of the same (Viz) all my Children to have
 an Equal Share thereof their names is John Henry and
 David son of Abraham & Christian & Rudolph of Carlisle
