In the County of West Chester, Henry Foster of the County of Chennandoah in the State of Virginia, being sick and weak in body but of sound memory (helped by god) do this sixteenth day of February in the year of our Lord, one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven make and publish this my last will & testament in manner following that

First it is my will & desire that all my just debts and funeral charges should be paid as soon as convenient after my decease

Item I do hereby give and bequeath unto my well beloved Daughter Catharina the full and sole possession of my Plantation whereon I live, as long as my well beloved Wife Ever lives he allowing her, the full Thirds of the produce of the Plantation & every Year During her Natural life he the said Daniel Thistle to pay or cause to be paid, the Taxes of the said Land during her life proportioned at the pleasure of my well beloved Wife Ever, the said Plantation to be sold for the highest price it will fetch, and the amount thereof to be equally Divided between my four well beloved Daughters (viz.) Ever Thistle wife of Daniel Thistle, Catharina, Anna Maria & Elizabeth Hiser I say I give & bequeath the same to them their heirs & Poheirs for ever.

Item I give and bequeath to my well beloved wife Ever her bed & Furniture and one Cow over the third of my moveable Estate.

Item I give and bequeath to my well beloved Daughter Catharina Anna Maria & Elizabeth I say I give to each of them before the Division of my moveable Estate One Mule, the value of eight pounds pencester Mille to the value of twenty five shillings Iron Castings to Twenty four Shillings Two Pairs one feather Bed & Furniture I say I give the same to each

of them their heirs or others forever
them It is my will and desire the remainder of my moveable Estate
be disposed of soon after my decease.

And I make and Ordain her my well beloved wife the Executor
and my beloved son in Law Daniel Hubble Executor of this my
will in trust for the intent and purposes in this my will contain-
ed and to take care and see the same performed according to my last

Intent & meaning. In Witness whereof the said Henry Hubble have
written my last will and Testament set my hand and seal, the Day
and year within written.
