ah County and State of Virginia being of sound memory, that
in a weak state of health think proper make this my last will and
testament which shall be in the following manner.

I sell my personal Estate and the use of one half of the Dwelling house
it being the back part of the house and next to the Spring house

Secondly I give and bequeath unto my son Mark Miller and to his
heirs and assigns for ever the upper part of my plantation it being the
part wherein the Dwelling and barn stands extending Down the
valley as far as to the first middle fence across the valley which said fence
is to be the line in the line between the upper part and the lower part
of the plantation a straight course from the lower corner of said Mark
Miller's Land which he bought of his Father George Miller to the
old line he being subject to the Devise above mentioned to my son
Them I give and bequeath unto my son Edward Miller and
to his heirs and assigns forever the lower part of my plantation
it being that part wherein heron lives extending from the
Lower line up the valley to the above mentioned ^{middle} fence
a cross the valley containing about forty acres let the same be
more or less

Here and lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my son -
Mark Miller Executor of this my last will and testaments whereof
I have herewith set my hand and seal this 10th day of Nov^r -
