discharged as soon as convenient after my decease I give devise
and bequeath unto my son Henry Hopkinson and my other son David
Hopkinson Plantation whereon I now live and all the Appurtenances
thereon I give devise and bequeath unto my said sons
Henry and David all my said Plantation as aforesaid to be by them
equally possessed to them and to their heirs and assigns for ever
I also give and bequeath of my Personal Estate as followeth
One Equal share thereof to my Daughter Magdalen Bucher, and
I also give and bequeath one Equal share thereof to my Daughter
Elizabeth Sparrow, I also give and bequeath to my Daughter Catharine
Hutchinson her Children one Equal share thereof, and I also give
and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Moller One Equal share thereof
and I also give and bequeath to my Daughter Ann Green one Equal
share thereof, it is my Will and desire that my said Daughters the said

Elizabeth Springator, I also give and bequeath to my Daughter Catherine
Husby Decemors her Children one equal share thereof, and I also give
and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Meller one equal share thereof
and I also give and bequeath to my Daughter Ann Gomer one equal
share thereof, I also give and bequeath to my Daughter Margaret
Belmont one equal share thereof, I also give and bequeath to my
Daughter Barbara Hiper one equal share thereof and her heirs
with her heirs and her Coheirs, I in further my will and desire that
if in case my said beaver before mentioned Daughters cannot agree
upon a Division of my estate and personal Estate amongst themselves
then my will and desire is that my said Personal shall be sold and
the money arising from such a sale shall be equally divided and
be paid amongst my said Daughters before mentioned, and con-
cerning the money which he has done I order and direct that my
said son David out of my personal Estate shall have one share
to wit at forty Pound Current money to be paid in two parts from
the date of his beaver and monies of my personal Estate and the
forty pound being carried over to the said Estate being said
by the said son David one equally divided among my said

Henry Piper and Stephen DeMearsh to be Executors to this will
with and Testament heretofore making and acknowledging
with the same at any time heretofore made In Witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand and seal this eighth day of September
