for ever he paying for the Debt or Title what is Due on the land in the said
Proportions of his together with the Accretions from those accruing there upon
and secondly I leave and Bequeath to my Beloved wife Mary Huyger all and
whichever my personal Estate that shall remain after my Just debts paid
and my funeral Charges and Time and to be after Deceased Equally divided amongst
my children that shall be then living another Testify and Declare to be
my last will and Testament hereby revoking and annulling all other
will or Wills ever by me made until this Date in Witness I have hereunto
set my hand and seal the Day and Year above Written
