

In the name of you amen I James McCarty of Henrico  
County & State of Virginia being sick in a low state of health in  
full of perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto god, calling to mind  
the shortness of my life and the uncertainty of death I have made this my last will and  
testament in manner following to wit

First it is my will that my dearly beloved wife Sarah shall during her natural  
life live with my son Jonas and that the said Jonas shall find and keep her  
so that she shall have no just cause to complain & that he shall perform  
duty or cause so to do by him or his heirs otherwise she shall have her full  
share of my Estate according as the Law directs further I give and bequeath  
th to my son Jonas all my lands and plantation whereon I now live  
to him his heirs and assigns for ever & besides all my moveable Estate  
now at this time in my possession to be his and that out of said Estate  
all my just debts to be paid and the said Jonas my son shall pay or  
give or cause to be given by him or his heirs or assigns or assignees to each of  
my other children for their full part out of said Estate now set to them  
the sum of 100 pounds and 10 shillings and 4 pence in manner

Left two pounds current lawful money of Virginia and to pay in manner  
following viz the first payment to be paid after one full year after my  
decease and then afterwards every year two pounds until the first payment  
to be to the oldest of them and so along yearly from the oldest to the young-  
est till each be paid the said sum of two pounds and then to be fully  
paid and discharged from paying any more the names of my said children

in all as follows viz Dianah Mary Hannah Elizabeth Sarah

Margret the said sum of two pounds to be paid to them their <sup>husbands</sup> <sup>and</sup> <sup>children</sup>  
further & Lastly I do constitute make and ordain my said son

George Adam Kirkle the sole executor of this my last will and  
testament and do hereby ratify disallow and revoke all former  
testaments wills legacies and bequests ratifying and confirming this  
and no other as being my last will and testament in writing
