rest of my personal Estate except my wife's things but my
desire is that my Lawfull debts that shall be owing at my
Decease shall be discharged & paid before any Decease is made
I my will & desire is that my son Charles shall pay unto my
two Daughters Betty & Sarah five pound each as their
part of my Estate he having already satisfied my three sons
William James & Benjamin as to their parts & for my other two
sons Henry & John I have given them their part to their full
satisfaction & I do likewise constitute & Ordain my will
