as convenient after my decease also an equal share of my personal estate with
the rest of my children after the decease of my beloved wife Catherine

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved son Michael Barnett an equal
share of my personal estate with the rest of my children after the decease of
my beloved wife Catherine. Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved
daughter Margaret Shaver wife of John Shaver an equal share of my per-
sonal estate after the decease of my beloved wife Catherine

Item I give and bequeath unto my friend George Boarden the sum of twenty
shillings in a two silver barrenes from William Barnett

First the my will void disease that all my last debts and funeral charges
be paid as soon as convenient after my decease.

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved son William Primm the sum of
five shillings in gold or Silver current money of Virginia to be paid him as soon
as convenient after my decease as an equal share of my personal estate with
the rest of my children after the decease of my beloved wife Catherine.

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved son Michael Primm an equal
share of my personal estate with the rest of my children after the decease of
my beloved wife Catherine. Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved
daughter Margaret the wife of John Shaver an equal share of my per-
sonal estate after the decease of my beloved wife Catherine.

Item I give and bequeath unto my friend George Borden the sum of twenty
shillings in gold or silver current money of Virginia as soon as convenient
after my decease as an equal share of my personal estate with the rest of my
beloved wife Catherine. Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved friend
Mary Borden daughter of Jacob Borden an equal share of my personal estate after the decease of
my beloved wife Catherine.

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I am my with and desire that my beloved wife Catharine with full pos-
session of my plantation wherein I now live a full possession of my mov-
able estate whatsoever I now am possessed withall her natural life and then at
her decease or as long as she remain in her widow hood for me. I do my will

~~that my plantation and house be sold after my decease and the~~
sale of my said plantation in the best manner they may think or can do to the
best of their Judgment and the amount of the sale of the same to be equal

divided between my two sons William & Michael Barnett - Margaret Shaver
and Mary Perkey four in Numbers I give and bequeath unto my said sons

my daughter and Mary Perkey with an equal share of my movable Estate
to them their heirs and assigns forever. I do hereby and ordain my two

beloved friends George Davis and Edward Tomlinson Executors of this my will
in trust for the intent & purposes in this my will contained to be lawfully and in the
