Christian burial at the Discretion of my Executors and Touching such
worldly estate where with it has pleased God to bless me in this life
and my wife and mine of the same in following manner and form as

First I give to my dearly beloved wife all the saffordes that
I hold and the house and Hamation that my son Peter shall have
if he shall leave the place that the Lord shall send
him and be Elgish Servant among my three Children Peter and John
and Paterson but my eldest Peter husband and his wife muchelin shall
be maintained out of the Hamation as long as the life but my wife
shall have the whole Hamation that my son John
shall have to be sixteen years at I believe for my wife make
and ordain them to be my last will and Testament in witness
whereof I have here set my hand and seal this Twenty first
day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
