gth I will send beneath the ~~same~~ ^{Henry} class that came of Retherston and
the place that I will send to my son James Dill and his
wifes. gth the lower end of my place that I will send to my
son and his wifes. I will send the upper end of the
place to my son Samuel Dill and his wifes only that he

knowing that it is appointed for all men once
die. Do make and pass this my last will and Testament that
is to say, Principally, and first of all I give and recommend my
soul into the hands of almighty God that I am it, and unto God's
Mercy and to the faith to be in him and to his true blood
and the remission of sinners. Nothing doubting but the General
and particular will receive the same my true heartily desired
God and as touching such worldly estate which he hath
blessed me I give to my son and to the bishops of the same in the following
manner and form

I give and bequeath the ~~same~~ place that I have of ^{Henry} Vetherton and
the place that I have of the Ragon to my son James Pole and his
heirs. I give the lower end of my place that I now live in to
the same my son James Pole and his heirs and the upper end of the
place I give unto my son Lawrence Pole and his heirs only that his
heirs shall live upon the place during their lives and after
the paying of my debts and my funeral expenses all the
remainder of my worldly estate I give and bequeath to
my daughter Elizabeth my wife

Beloved wife and children, I do hereby bequeath and I do hereby bequeath
to be equally divided amongst my children

I do hereby bequeath and I do hereby bequeath my good Friends Elizabeth
and Samuel to be executors of this my last will
and Testament and I do hereby disallow and utterly dis-

allow all and every other former testament or will, Legacies
Bequests and Executors, by me in any ways before made, wills
and Bequests, Ratifying, and confirming this and so
that to be my last will and Testament.
