I also give and bequeath unto each of the Children of Mary Weston and Susanna that is the sum of one Shilling Sterling money a piece and therein I will that God with His Grace shall be set free from and immediately after my decease and also give unto them one year's Pension and all the arrangement of my little estate and personal Estate and also give and bequeath unto my daughter Mary Deagan and her children and also unto my daughter Susanna and her children and appoint my well beloved son John Deagan to be the executor of my will and to see that my last will and Testament shall be performed I have hereunto set my hand and seal this second day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & seventy two
