In the name of god amen the 11th day of March one
thousand seven hundred and ^{Southampton County, Virginia Wills 1772-1782} ~~only~~ ^{fifty} five Ambrose Grizard of the
parish of St Lukes and county of Southampton, being very sick but
of sound and perfect sense and memory thanks be to god do make
this my last will and testament

Imprimis I give and bequeath my soul to Almighty god that
gave it to me in a sure and certain hope of a glorious Resur-
rection, and my body to be decently buried at the discretion
of my Executors hereafter mentioned -

Item I give my son John Grizard one feather bed and
furniture which he has now in possession

Item I give my son Ambrose Grizard all my wear and gold
except my great coat and boots

Item I give Hannah Senter one cow and calf and all her
things

Item I give my son Isaac Grizard the plantation
known unto him and his heirs for ever and when he shall
have my whole estate of all kinds whatsoever with the same
lotions

My will and desire is that my daughters Betsey Senter and
and Prescilla Grizard may be maintained on the plantation
by my son Isaac Grizard untill they arrive to the age of sixteen
years and then for him to pay them such portions as he shall
see fit

I do appoint my son Isaac Grizard my whole and sole
executor of this my last will and testament in witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and date
above written

hem my whole estate of real and personal
lations

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My will and desire that my daughter Betsey Slat and
and Prescilla Giza may be married in the plantation
by my son James Giza untill they arrive to the age of 21 years
years and then for him to pay them 50 pounds

I do appoint my son James Giza my whole and sole
of this my last will and Testament in witness whereof
I have set my hand and seal the day and year
