Here I give unto my Daughter Mary Ghies power the
Plantation whereon I now live of the Land thereunto
Belonging also to ^{Waters} ~~Waters~~ Dishes one Iron Pot & one
Feather Bed and Furniture

Here I give to my Daughter Sarah Ghies power
for ever the first Child that ever my Negro Girl Hannah
shall be delivered of & that it be Permitted to suck its
Mother twelve months as also 4 Benter Plates two Dishes
one Iron Pot & one Feather Bed & Furniture

Here I give my Daughter Elizabeth Abraham wife of John
Abraham one Pound Current Money of Virginia

Here I give unto my ^{Grand} Daug Martha Abraham one Cow & calf
Here I give unto my Grand Daug Sarah Abraham one Cow & calf
