3rdly. I give unto my son John King a piece of land &
plantation containing about one hundred & fifty acres of land
which lyeth in Nansemond County bounded by a line or row of white
oaks on the North side of a branch known & commonly called the
Wolf Pitt branch & likewise south bounded by the North side of
main swamp common by known & called the head of the Southwre
Branch of Nansemond the same being part of a patent bearing
date 1666 the same being also a part
of one hundred acres of the said patent which the said John King
formerly did sell to Edw. Pellice which with him after
I give unto my son John Simon his heirs & assigns forever
4thly. I give unto my son Jacob Simon my Smiths tools
consisting in one pair Well hoes, one Anvil, Hedges & hammer, flacks
Dife & bands, Vices, screw plates, rubbers & files, &c. & I give him
generall all what is before. & Appertaining unto the same tools.
I give unto son Jacob Simon with three guns & one pair of powder
should I said I give unto my son Jacob Simon and to his
disposing after my decease.

5thly That my Will & desire Sarah Simon my wife should
 enjoy all my estate with the cattle hoggs & sheep without
 molestation during her Widow hood and after her decease
 to be equally divided among my Daughters

6thly This is my last Will & Testament in Witness
 whereof I the said Augustine Simon have with my
 hand and fixed my Seal the Twentieth day of January
 one thousand seven hundred & forty five
