I leave my Father William Pope Executor and Meley Pope Exec in  
full to see their Parts equally Divided among them all Last Will  
hereby revoking all others by me heretofore made In Witness my  
I the Benjamin Pope have hereunto set my hand and Seal this  
twenty first Day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand  
seven hundred fifty one.
