 Parish of Northway being sick and weak of body but of sound Perfect sense & Memory
 And of a disposing mind & calling to mind the uncertainty of this Transitory life and
 knowing that it is Appointed for all men to die do think proper to make this my last
 Will and testament in manner and form following to wit:

I Give and bequeath to my son *Nelson Wade* the land and Plantation wherein he
 and his family now dwells being One hundred Acres to him and his heirs.

I Give unto my friend *Sarah Turner* during natural life the use of the plantation
 wherein I now dwell being the land as it is right of *Samuel Elly* also *Walter* & *John*

I Give unto my friend *Sarah Turner* five of her choice of my Cattle Also 3 Sows and
 fifteen Hens and Bed and furniture I'm large Iron Pot - two Pewee's and a Lamb one
 Chest One Trunk small Pewee's Basin and one Plate

I Give unto my Grand son *John Wade* the land and Plantation after the death
 of *Sarah Turner* which I have lent to her and the slaves long as I have lent to her and
 in case my Grand son *John Wade* dies before he arrives to the age of twenty one years Having
 no issue of his body lawfully begotten then I Give the said land to my Grand son
Samuel Wade and his heirs

Item it is my Will and desire that all the rest of my estate not already mentioned be
 Equally divided among my wife *Ann* *Ann Wade* my son *Nelson Wade* my daughter
Sarah Wade and my daughter *Martha Wade* to them & their heirs

Lastly I do hereby constitute *Andrew* & *Apprentice* my Executors I make
 Bequeath my whole and sole Executors of this my last Will and testament I'm
William Wade have signed to it with my hand and seal

no more of his body lawfully gotten then I Give the said Land to my Grand son
Samuel Wade Tabern and his Heirs
Hem it is my Wife and does of 1785

the year of our Lord Christ One thousand Seven hundred Eighty and one
