

I in the Name of God Amen I Collier Person of Southampton being
 sick and weak in body but of sound and disposing mind and memory
 do make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament in the following
 manner To wit First and foremost I recommend my soul to Almighty
 God who gave it in sure and certain expectation of the same and as for
 what worldly Goods it hath pleased God to bestow upon me I dispose of as follows
 Viz I Give the use of all my Estate after my Just debts being paid to my
 loving wife Elizabeth Person untill my daughter Mary Person arriv to the
 age of fifteen years or untill my said wifes Marriage for the Support of her
 and my Children And then my said Estate shall be equally divided
 Between my wife and all her Children lawfully born to her and in Case either
 die without Issue then said Estate to be equally divided Between them and
 Surviving to them and their heirs forever And I do Appoint my loving wife
 and Brother Philip Person Executors of my last will and Testament

Last Witness which I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal
 this 13 day of November 1780. Collier Person (Seal)

Signed Seal'd and acknowledged at a Court held for the County of Southampton the 9
 day of May 1782. Then Wills were presented in Court by Elizabeth
 Person & Philip Person the Executors therein named & Probated by the Court
 of Thomas Person a Justice of the Peace and a Justice of the Peace
 and on the Motion the same Wills were read & the same were
 then read out again & therefor a Certificate was
 given by the Court accordingly.
